Canadian Students: Funding to Support Participation at the CIE 30th Quadrennial Session, CIE 2023 - Innovative Lighting Technologies. Ljubljana, Slovenia, September 18-20, 2023

The CIE is an independent, non-profit organization that serves its member countries and the global community, representing the best authority on all aspects of light and lighting. The broad theme of the CIE 2023 conference is "Innovative Lighting Technologies". The CIE especially invites abstract submissions for the conference on:

- Smart lighting;
- Sustainable and resilient lighting technologies and practices;
- Integrative lighting for outdoors and indoors;
- Metrology for new technologies; and
- Image display in augmented and virtual reality modes.

Submissions related to the CIE Divisions: Vision and Colour; Physical Measurement of Light and Radiation; Interior Environment and Lighting Design; Transportation and Exterior Applications; Photobiology and Photochemistry; and Image Technology are also encouraged.

The Canadian National Committee of the CIE will support one Canadian student to present their research at the 30th Quadrennial Session. The student must be the presenting author of a paper accepted at the CIE 2023 Session. Students in all fields of inquiry relevant to the scope of the CIE are eligible, including physics, vision science, optometry, psychology, architecture, engineering, lighting design, and biology. The successful applicant will be reimbursed by the CNC/CIE for up to \$750 of expenses related to the conference (registration, travel accommodation, meals). Following the conference, they will be expected to report on their experiences at the conference, either in a short written report or in a presentation at the online fall 2023 meeting of the CNC/CIE.

Applying for CNC/CIE support is a two-stage process. First, students must submit their work to the CIE 2023 conference. The conference web page <https://slovenia2023.cie.co.at/> provides more information about the meeting and abstract submission. The CIE abstract submission deadline is March 5, 2023.

Second, students must apply to the CNC/CIE using the attached application form. This submission must include a copy of the abstract submitted to the CIE conference portal and confirmation that the submission was accepted for presentation. Applications will be judged based on the quality of the abstract. Applications must be received by May 15, 2023, to be considered.
